

# 32 Three Kinds of Recordings

*This page presents the three ways you can make recordings.*

## *First*

*Here, you can make a simple Tape Recorder type of call. All you do is dial the phone number "YesRecords", (937 732-6737) You will hear a slight bell and then the recording will begin. When you're done you hang up.*

## *Second*

*Here, you can make a recorded call. All you do is dial the phone number, "RecordCall" (732 673-2255). You will hear a prompt that will say, enter the 10-digit phone number, that you want to call. The system will automatically, make a recorded call, to the phone number that you entered. You will be on a recorded call.*

## *Third*

*Record a call, that you received. This feature, does not work on land lines. It only works on iPhones and Android Phones*

*Follow the steps below. a) answer the call*

*b) find favorites*

*c) touch Record*

*d) wait for "merge calls" to light up*

*e) touch "merge calls".*

*The call is now being recorded. The entire procedure b) through e) takes about 4 seconds.*

*We suggest, that after you answer the call, you don't say hello, or speak, until you press the "merge button".*

*Then you can speak, and tell the caller that the call is being recorded.*

## **ABSTRACT**

*"A system and method for recording a session is provided. One session related to first and second parties may be established.*

*Another session related to the first party and a recording server may be established.*

*The sessions may be joined and the common session may be recorded by the recording server.*

*A recorded session may be recorded by the recording server.*

*A recorded session may be stored and played back"*
